4. **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS FIRST READING:**
 - (a) A Resolution authorizing the City to pay to the Ohio Department of Transportation a portion of the cost of replacing an existing steel bridge superstructure; and declaring an emergency. (A-10-28)
5. Consideration of a "Liquor Agency Contract" **Explanation:** Risor Foods (Giant Eagle) has a regular liquor permit to sell beer/wine. They want to become state liquor agency. This would allow them to sell high proof alcohol (such as Vodka, Rum, Whiskey, etc). If anyone has ever been to Apples, formerly Tops, they had a sort of separated room in the grocery store where they sold this type of liquor. What you are voting on is whether you want to object to this and want to have a hearing on this request as you would possibly be against this.
6. Consideration of a new liquor permit for Chiptole Mexican Grill at 901 Leavitt Road. This is for a D3 license: Spirituous liquor for on premise consumption only until 1:00 A. M. (this is the present Donato's building)
