Swim Lessons 2010

For **members only**, sign-ups will start on June 5th at 12:00 noon. Additional dates for **members only** will be June 6 - 9 during normal pool operating hours (see above).

Non-members and members will have an opportunity to sign-up for any remaining lesson times starting June 10th at 12:00 noon.

Persons wishing to register for lessons may only select two sessions at a time. The cost of lessons is \$42.00 per child, per session. Payment must be made when registering for lessons. All checks can be made payable to: City of Amherst.

Children, age of 4 and older, may be registered for levels 1 - 4 only. Sessions are Monday through Friday on the following dates:

Session I:	June 21 – July 2
Session II:	July 5 – July 16
Session III:	July 19 – July 30

There are two class times available: 10:15 - 10:50 a.m.
(Run time 35 minutes.) 11:00 - 11:35 a.m.

Amherst Park Commission 2010 Pool Pass Policies

Family Passes:

A family pass includes four (4) individuals living in one family home. Children age 3 and under are free. Any additional family members must pay the additional membership fee. **Children born before 09-01-99 will receive an adult pass. Children age 10 and younger must be accompanied by a responsible person, age 16 or older.**

Baby-sitter passes will not be available for 2010. Residents of Amherst City or Amherst School District who baby-sit children who do not reside with them (whether or not they are relatives) may purchase a pool pass at the family rate or single rate, however, the children must either have their own family or single pass or pay the "with member" daily rate.

Refunds:

No refunds will be given on any type of membership or swimming lessons.

Swim Team:

The swim team membership pass allows the individual to use the pool for swim team practice and swim meets only. Any other use of the pool requires the payment of the daily rate. Lifeguards employed at the Amherst pool and on the swim team are not required to purchase a swim team membership. Daily rates for those with "swim team only" memberships are \$8.00 unless they qualify for the with-member rate of \$5.00.
