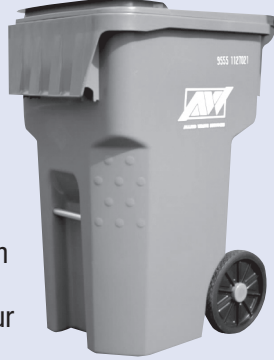


General Information

Time of Collection: To ensure your recycling and rubbish materials removal, please place the rubbish on the opposite side of your driveway from the recyclables, by **6:00 A.M.**



Day of Collection: Recycling and rubbish materials will be picked up on the same day each week EXCEPT when a holiday falls on or before your regular pick up day. Then your recycling and rubbish materials will be collected one day late.

HOLIDAYS THAT AFFECT COLLECTIONS ARE THE FOLLOWING:

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day

Containers:

The standard containers are 96 gallon and 68 gallon. A second container is available at additional cost. Contact Allied Waste for details at 440-458-5191.

Container placement: Place container within 3 feet of the curb with the arrows facing the street, on the opposite side of your drive from the mailbox.

Note: Do not place containers at the curb prior to 5:00 P.M. on the day before collection. Please remove empty containers within 12 hours after collection.

City of Amherst Recycling and Rubbish Rules and Regulations for Single Family Homes and Condos

*If you reside in a multi-family complex these rules and regulations may not apply to you.

In order to minimize the cost of collection, a mechanized truck will now be used for trash collection and all trash must now be placed in the container supplied by Allied Waste. All your general refuse materials must be placed in the container provided. No other containers or bags will be taken.

Containers will be delivered the weeks of February 4th and February 11th and only the container should be placed out on your next scheduled pick up day.

PERMITTED REFUSE

- Food Waste – drained, wrapped and placed in a plastic bag.
- Other trash – juice boxes, paper containers, waste paper, etc.
- Sharp items, broken glass, syringes, etc.
Place in puncture-proof container prior to placing in cart.

ITEMS BELOW PICKED UP ON THE 2ND FULL WEEK OF THE MONTH ON REGULAR PICKUP DAY

- Household furniture, carpeting, etc.
- Tables, swing sets, and television sets, etc.
- Refrigerators, freezers – DOORS REMOVED – FREON REMOVED
- Window AC Units & Dehumidifiers – FREON REMOVED
- Washers and dryers
- Christmas trees picked up the second full week of January

NOT PERMITTED AT CURB

- Large car parts, tires, batteries, etc.
- Liquids

NOTE: CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF BUILDING MATERIALS AND DEBRIS

Recycling Rules & Regulations

COMMINGLED MATERIALS

How to Participate — Collect aluminum, steel, and bi-metal cans, plastics #1 and #2, glass bottles and jars and place them together (commingled) in your blue plastic bag. Please only use blue plastic bags to place these materials at the curb.

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, JUNKMAIL AND CEREAL BOXES IN BUNDLES

How to Participate — Stack newspapers, Junkmail and magazines and tie securely with twine or stack inside blue plastic bags. Place bundles of newspapers and magazines next to your blue bags and away from your rubbish.



CARDBOARD

Large cardboard boxes must be broken down, tied and stacked next to blue bags.



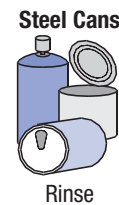
BLUE BAG PROGRAM

Collect aluminum cans, steel cans, plastics #1 and #2, glass bottles and jars and place them together (commingled) in your blue plastic bag.

Blue bags may be purchased at wherever garbage bags are sold.

Items Excluded From Recycling Collections

Window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, mirrors or ceramics, and plastic containers that are contaminated, i.e. motor oil, antifreeze, pesticide and herbicide containers and those with food. Place above items and empty containers in trash container.

Yard Waste Rules and Regulations

Separate yard waste collection will take place from April 15th thru November 30th on your regular pickup day.

GRASS CLIPPINGS AND OTHER YARD WASTE FOR COMPOSTING:

All grass clippings and other yard waste should be placed in brown paper yard waste bags or cans not to exceed 40 lbs. next to blue bags.

BRUSH AND SMALL TREE TRIMMINGS

Must be cut, bundled and securely tied not exceeding 4 feet in length or 40 lbs. and placed next to blue bags.

Note: Grass clippings and other yard waste may be placed in cart and will be collected with the rubbish materials.

Note: Landscapers and tree services are responsible for removal of any yard waste they generate while working at a residence.
